Dear Mr. Grover:

In response to your letter of July 2, I am pleased to suggest that the assessors of the town of Waite may petition the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to place a bounty on bears killed in the unincorporated town of Topsfield.

The Commissioner can hold a hearing and authorize bounties to be paid for bears killed in the unincorporated town of Topsfield which appears to be adjoining the town of Waite.

Section 79 on Page 43 of the Fifth Biennial Revision of the Fish and Game Laws seems to describe the necessary procedure.
