Dear Sir:

Kindly refer to my letter of May 27th, 1941, in regard to State excise tax in connection with operation of the Androscoggin and Kennebec Railway Company and its successor, the Lewiston-Auburn Transit Company.

I have been going over the facts and Section 30 of Chapter 12 of the Revised Statutes with Mr. Berman, attorney for the Lewiston-Auburn Transit Company, and on the facts as I now see them, this tax should be assessed against the Receiver of the Androscoggin and Kennebec Railway Company and not against the Lewiston-Auburn Transit Company.
