In re Physicians Examination
for Application for Marriage
License.

My understanding of the words
"physical examination" contained in Section
1 of Chapter 202, Public Laws of 1941, is
that it must be made by a physician licensed
to practice in Maine, which, with the standard
blood test as required by the Bureau of Health,
may be accepted by town or city clerks.
