To S. F. Dorrance, Livestock Specialist Re: Fees in Unorganized Territory

There does not appear to be any provision of statute directly applicable to the payment of dog killing fees in unorganized territory.

There is a provision that the officer is entitled to \$2. for each dog.

We think it proper for the Clerk of St. Agatha to take the amount due the officers out of the license fees collected, returning to you the balance of such collections.
