Dear Sir:

In re Proceedings in the Supreme Judicial  
Court in Equity - City of Auburn v.  
Colonial Beacon Oil Company and  
George E. Hill, and City of Auburn v.

municipalities of gasoline tax and  
tax on fuel oil for diesel engines  
to the State of Maine
