In re Collection of Accounts Receivable

I have your memorandum of November 7th. In my opinion, Chapter 13, P. L. 1941, reduces the responsibility of the Etate Treasurer as provided in Chapter 317, P. L. 1940, approved April 23, 1940, and appearing on Page 30 of the Laws of 1941. The only duty remaining for the Treasurer in connection with that matter is so receive the payment, or any portion thereof, if it should come in at some time in spite of having been charged off. What your bookkeeping system should be in that regard is purely administrative and I will make no suggestion.
