Dear Sir:

In response to your letter of October 14th, I am pleased to inform you that Section 52, to which you refer, evidently has reference to commercial vehicles, not including busses.

Section 69, to which you refer, evidently refers to passenger cars having a seating capacity of more than 7 passengers which shall be operated at a speed not in excess of 45 miles per hour.

With reference to plates, mentioned in Section 59, This evidently refers to commercial vehicles referred to in Section 52, and also to passenger busses mentioned in Section 69, having a seating capacity of more than 7 passengers.

Should you still be in doubt, it is possible that by communicating with the Secretary of State you might receive additional information.
