Dear Sir:

In re D. Herman Corson

I have your request for an ~~an~~ opinion, dated January 18th. Mr. Corson is entitled to retirement on a basis of one-half of his average salary for the last ~~four~~ years he has been in the employ of the State without regard to whether or not his employment was continuous in one department.

However, if he accepts the retirement allowance he must surrender his \$375. a year teacher's pension because the statute does not permit a person to be drawing two pensions from the State at the same time.
