If an employee of a summer camp desires that his employer shall retain custody of the employee's wages, or any part of those wages, for delivery to the employee in amounts other than the amount of a weekly wage, it is perfectly proper that such an arrangement be made, provided it is made voluntarily by the employee and is not in any way connected with the contract of employment.

In order to protect the employer and the employee, I suggest that if such an agreement is entered into, that it be in writing and signed by both parties and each party retain a copy. Note that in any such case, the law itself expressly that the agreement be in writing.
