Dear Sire

I have your communication of February 25th, in regard to exemption from taxation of gasoline used in the Forest Service plane.

The proper thing to do, I believe, will be to have a Council Order authorizing the Finance Department to restore to your budget any such amounts as may be transferred to the Treasury through the Tax Bureau by reason of the wording of the amendment of R. S. Chapter 12, Section 89, which appears as Chapter 316, Public Laws of 1941, Approved on Jamuary 24, 1942.
