To Henry P. Weaver, Chief, State Police  
Re: Chapter 231, Acts and Resolves, 1942 Special Session.

The words "working directly" in your first question, and "not on pay by the county" in your second are somewhat indefinite.

It seems to me that deputy sheriffs and reserve police officers are prohibited from carrying loaded rifles and shotguns in their cars on the highways at all times when not engaged in the business for which they were appointed.
