I have examined the law regarding use of the Contingent Fund, as requested in your memo of April 22nd.

In my opinion it is perfectly proper for the Governor and Council to order transferred from the State Contingent Fund money to enable the Potato Tax Committee to conduct further research work on potato by-products. R. S. Chapter 2, Section 103, plainly covers such use.
