I have your memo of April 27th, referring to mine of April 24th, replying to yours of April 22nd.

You are, in my opinion, absolutely correct in your interpretation of the meaning of sub-paragraph (2) in connection with the potato tax law. Discretion as to the use of the balance of the fund lies with the Maine Development Commission. It certainly is not necessary under the law that additional research work must necessarily be done by the Experiment Station.
