In re Reward Apprehension Inmates of State School for Boys,

I am pleased to call your attention to P. L. 1933, Chapter 1, Section 309, the last paragraph of which reads as follows:

"It shall be the duty of any sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, police officer or other person finding any fugitive from any of said institutions at large to apprehend them without a warrent and return said fugitive to the institution from which the escape was made or to any officer or agent of the department. Such officer shall be paid a reasonable compensation by the state for his services."
