Dear Sir:

I have your memo of June 4th asking about the bonding of individuals in the pari mutuel department. The bonds covering the licensee should cover defalcations by individuals employed directly or indirectly by the licensee who handle any money. If it is impracticable to do it this way the bond of the pari mutuel operator should cover each and every individual in the pari mutuel department. Thus the law will be observed and it will not be necessary to pay \$5.00 for a special bond for a man to work a single afternoon on which occasion he may handle one hundred or so dollars.
