With reference to the proposed resolution to be adopted by the Trustees of the Joint Contributory Retirement System, you are advised that the trustees have authority to adopt such a resolution and that the adoption of such a resolution is advisable.

In connection with the draft which you submitted, it is suggested that the last phrase of the last clause might read in substance as follows: If such employee fails to resume his former status in the State's service he shall be deemed to have abandoned his employment.
