In reply to your memorandum of August 7, 1942, relative to Chapter 325, Special Session 1942, you are advised that if there is an established State base scale of pay, that base scale is to be increased 10%, but if Departments and Institutions of the State engage persons on a per hour or per diem basis the price at which the employee is hired is the wage to be paid. It is not necessary to pay the employee 10% more than he was hired for.
