In reply to your memorandum of September 9th, 1942, you are advised that under the provisions of Chapter 309 of the Public Laws of 1941, the Commissioner of Agriculture may approve the offering of prizes to assist in the promotion of animal industry, or such other methods of promotion as will, together with other items of expense to be defrayed by the appropriation made therefore, not exceed \$7,000.
