In reply to your memorandum of September 22, 1942, you are advised that the words "the terms and provisions of such trust" as used in Chapter 84, Public Laws of 1941, refer to Section 50 and following Sections of Chapter 80 of the Nevised Statutes of 1950.

Ministerial and school funds can only be legally entrusted with the State Treasurer when there has been a vote of the town authorising the trustees of such funds to turn the same over to the State Treasurer.
