In reply to your memorandum of September 22, 1942, you are advised that the words "the terms and provisions of such trust" as used in Chapter 84, Public Laws of 1941, refer to Section 80 and following Sections of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes of 1930.

Ministerial and school funds can only be legally entrusted with the State Treasurer when there has been a vote of the town authorizing the trustees of such funds to turn the same over to the State Treasurer.
