Your letter of November 23rd, addressed to the Attorney General, has been turned over to the writer for reply.

In spite of the unfortunate situation you find yourselves in as far as plumbing work is concerned, a study of Section 61 of Chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes of 1930 and decisions of the courts in connection therewith, make it necessary for this department to render an opinion that it would not be proper to use the Eldridge Co. even on the small jobs that would not warrant bids.
