The Meine Unemployment Compensation Commission

Gentlement

I have your request for an opinion as to whether, in view of the recent death of the Chairman of the Meine Transployment Compensation Commission, the two surviving members of the Commission constitute such a commission that it has full power to edminister the provisions of the Meine Unemployment Compensation law.

It is my opinion that the two surviving Conmissioners do, under the provisions of Section 13 (c) of the Act, possess the right to exercise all the powers of the Commission except that so appeal hearings under Section 18 (c) can be hold until an impartial member of the Board is appointed. However, as a matter of fact, there are no apposis penning before the Board and the Governor has made it clear thems that it is his desire to appoint an impartial member for the Board at the earliest possible soment.
