In my opinion, checks issued by the State on the first Wednesday of January of the odd-numbered year should properly carry the signatures of the State Controller and the State Treasurer who is in office at the time when the Legislature convenes for the purpose of electing his successor. They should be recegnized as valid orders of the State against the depository banks for the payment of the amounts appearing on the faces of the checks.
