Your memo of January 22, 1943, in re Louise Pike

It is the opinion of this department that you are correct in your interpretation of the law in regard to violation of parole, under which interpretation you would hold the above mentioned Louise Pike beyond February 1, 1943 a sufficient length of time to make up for the period November 10, 1941 to February 2, 1943. It is understood that this period is the period during which she was considered a parole violator.
