Special Constables' Commission

In answer to your memorandum on the above question I am pleased to advise as follows:

The Special Constables' Commission you refer to, is according to my understanding, issued under Chapter 284, P. L. 1917 under the special war powers given the Governor at that time. This Special Constable is not the same as detectives who are licensed by the State under other provisions of the statutes.

The service rendered as such a constable is service to the State which, in the opinion of this department, may be counted for pension purposes.
