I have been thinking about the opinion I sent you yesterday concerning the destruction of cancelled state bonds. While the conclusion of law given in the opinion is sound, I believe the procedure as suggested is impractical. Although these cancelled bonds are not, strictly speaking, records within the provisions of the statute, nevertheless, as I consider the matter further, I believe it will be much more wise, if we have them destroyed under order of the committee set up by the legislature for that purpose.
