is in the opinion of this department that you are carrent in your feeling that Section 4 of Chapter 320 of the Public Learn of 1943 repeals Section 6 of Chapter 130 of the Public Learn of 1935 and that particle of Section 9. Chapter 139, P.L. 1935, referring to bands.

Said Sention 4 of Chapter 180 does not repeal Section 18 of Chapter 130, P.L. 1935, as the pareons required therein to be bunded use not Sinte employees.

While, as you mention, there are no items in the section law which are specifically listed as being repealed, you will note that it does repeal all sums of the legislature dealing with bonds to be fundament by stope officials and employees ether than the space treasurer, and that the specific ensembles itself are "without listed are "without list taking" upon the general repealing clause.
