Reference is to your memorandum of August 11th.

It is the opinion of this department that you are correct in your feeling that Section 4 of Chapter 130 of the Public Laws of 1943 repeals Section 4 of Chapter 130 of the Public Laws of 1935 and that portion of Section 2, Chapter 139, P.L. 1935, referring to bonds.

Said Section 4 of Chapter 130 does not repeal Section 14 of Chapter 130, P.L. 1935, as the persons required therein to be bonded are not State employees.

While, as you mention, there are no items in the section law which are specifically listed as being repealed, you will note that it does repeal "all acts of the legislature dealing with bonds to be furnished by state officials and employees other than the state treasurer," and that the specific enactments listed are "without limitation" upon the general repealing clause.
