I have your memo of August 18th in regard to bonds of trial and municipal court justices, specifically R. S. Chapter 148, Section 8.

It is my opinion that \$\overline{\text{P}}\$? L. 1943, Chapter 320 was not intended to repeal the provisions of the above mentioned section.

You will note in the latter part of the section: "Every such justice or judge who shall perform any such official acts before giving such bond forfeits not more than \$100. to be recovered by indictment." I suggest that you send to this office a record of any municipal court judges or trial justices who have performed official acts "before giving such bond." and I will send the matter to the proper county attorneys for indictment.
