To Captain Laurence Upton, Acting Chief, State Police  
Re: Volunteers not Members of Organization holding Beano License

In answer to your question of September 30th, inquiring whether a person who is a member of the licensing organization and has exclusive control over the game of Beano, can be assisted by volunteer wprlers who are not members of the licensing organization,

After reading the regulations and the statute regarding this, there does not appear to be any objection to this being done. Over the phone this morning you stated that in most of these cases the volunteer services were being rendered by the wives of members of organizations and, in a practical sense, there would not seem to be any objection to this, either.
