At the time we discussed this matter I did not give special study to the charter of the City of Briddeford and advised you solely in connection with the general law of the State. Since that time I have given special consideration and thought to the Briddeford charter and to the question as to whether or not the provision in that charter authorizing the city to employ a superintendent of schools takes precedence over the general law. In my opinion it does take such precedence and the City of Briddeford is not subject to the provision of our statute in requiring that it join in a school union.
