From Frank I. Cowan, Attorney General

I have conferred with Mr. Donahue, Assistant Attorney General, assigned to the Industrial Accident Commission, and he advises that council orders in regard to payments under the Workmen's Compensation Act be dispensed with. Inasmuch as it is his peculiar duty to handle points of law involving the Commission, I accept his advice in such matters in the absence of controversy, and even in the case of controversy his opinion would bear the presumption of correctness until proved incorrect.
