Subject: Alfred W. Perkins, Insurance Commissioner -- Military Leave

I am returning herewith the application of Alfred W. Perkins, Insurance Commissioner, for military leave. It seems to me that no particular form of reply is necessary. A simple memo, couched in friendly terms, to appear in the files so that the attitude of the present administration will be plainly evident to a future Governor, may be a good thing. The Governor should acknowledge receipt of the application for leave of absence and state that such leave is granted for a period not longer than the remaining portion of the term of office for which Mr. Perkins was appointed.
