To the Bridge Division, SHC From Abraham Breitbard, Deputy Attorney General

There has been submitted to this office for approval the specifications, contract, bend and proposal of the bridge over Hodgdon Stream in the tewn of Houlton. The contractor is Hector J. Cyr Co., which appears to be a partnership composed of Hector J. Cyr and Ferdinand Cyr. In the bond submitted the principal is named as Hector J. Cyr Co. This is an incorrect way of describing a partnership for the purposes of a bond under seal. The name of the principal should be written as follows, after the word "that" in the first line of the bond: "We, Hector J. Cyr and Ferdinand Cyr of Waterville in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, co-partners doing business under the name and style of Hector J. Cyr Company, as principal, etc." The bond should be signed by each of the partners under seal, they signing their individual names and stating that they do business under the name and style of Hector J. Cyr Co.

We notice that the contract is written the same way, but that is not so important as the bond which is under seal, and after these corrections I should be pleased to approve the same.
