Dear Sir:

I have your letter of July 12th, in regard to the possibility of organizing a Third Party here in Maine.

The procedure appears in R. S. Chapter 7, §§ 30 to 38, inclusive. The particular regulations are in §§ 32, 33 and 34. From your letter I understand that the American Democratic National Committee has a copy of our election law so they can turn directly to the sections to which I have referred.

This procedure is unusual here in Maine so we have not developed any extra legal steps and a literal compliance with the statute will be correct. Blank forms may be obtained from the office of the Secretary of State.
