August 9, 1944 To Harold I. Goss, Secretary of State From Abraham Breitbard, Deputy Attorney General With reference to your oral inquiry made this day regarding refund of the operator's license fee paid by applicants serving in the armed forces of the United States and who would be entitled to a renewal thereof without the parameter of any fee therefor under P. L. 1943, Chapter 157:-I advise you that in view of the opinions written interpreting this statute dated July 13, 1944 and July 27, 1944, the applicants who have paid for their licenses to operate, but who under this provision would be entitled to a license without payment of any fee therefor, are entitled to a refund.
