To Fred M. Berry, State Auditor
From Ralph W. Farris, Attorney General

. . . In accordance with Chapter 16, Section 4, of the Revised Statutes of 1944, the State Auditor, if he shall find in the course of his audit, evidence of illegal transaction, ~~he~~ shall forthwith report such transaction to the Governor and the Attorney General. In the case at hand, I believe it is your duty to notify any delinquent county officer who has not kept a satisfactory record of his fees and has failed to pay them to the county treasurer, as provided by law; and if he still refuses to comply with the law, you may notify my office, and I will take the matter up with the delinquent county officer and see if the law cannot be complied with, or ascertain the reason why.
