... In accordance with Chapter 16, Section 4, of the Revised Statutes of 1944, the State Auditor, if he shall find in the course of his audit, evidence of illegal transaction, he shall forthwith report such transaction to the Governor and the Attorney General. In the case at hand, I believe it is your duty to notify any delinquent county officer who has not kept a satisfactory record of his fees and has failed to pay them to the county treasurer, as provided by law; and if he still refuses to comply with the law, you may notify my office, and I will take the matter up with the delinquent county officer and see if the law cannot be complied with, or ascertain the reason why.
