To Guy R. Whitten, Deputy Commissioner, Insurance

I have your memo of July 25th relating to the amendment to the State insurance laws enacted by the 92nd legislature. You ask the following questions:

1. If the 2% tax is to be levied upon all gross direct premiums and also upon assessments after deductions as outlined in Section 135 are applied?

My answer to this question is in the affirmative.

2. If under Section 135 the companies or their agents are responsible in their tax return to this department for computing the tax as provided in Sections 131 and 133?

My answer to this question is in the affirmative.
