Dear Mr. Rendall,

Your letter of August 1st received, relating to the provisions of Chapter 353 of the Public Laws of 1945, entitled, "AN ACT Relating to the Permanent School Fund."

• Since my conference with you and the Commissioner of Education and the Finance Commissioner, I have studied this amendment to Section 195 of Chapter 37, R. S. 1944, and I am of the opinion that the legislature intended by that amendment that a sum not to exceed \$5000 annually should be made available to the Forest Commissioner for management and improvement of growth on the public reserved lots, and I believe that it would be feasible to make arrangements to make this sum available from the income of this fund, for the purposes indicated in the amendment.
