To Earle R. Hayes, Secretary, Employees' Retirement System  
Re: Holding up Refund in Embezzlement Case (Bangor; Motor Vehicles)

My impression is that some one from the Controller's office came up and asked whether this refund to Miss \_\_\_\_\_ should be paid, where she has been arrested and bound over for embezzlement of funds from the State.

I told him, and in fact advised him, that we would be justified in holding up the refund until moneys belonging to the State and established to have been embezzled by Miss \_\_\_\_\_ were repaid.
