With regard to your memorandum of February 7th, this department is of the opinion that, upon application to the Commission for a permit to transport over the highways and bridges of the State loads in excess of 40,000 lbs. (gross weight of vehicle and load), the Commission may inquire into the registration of the said motor vehicle and if it finds that it is registered for a rated capacity under 12 tons, it may require such applicant to register said motor truck and pay the difference in registration fee for the maximum rated capacity of \$300, before issuing a permit.
