To Earl Hutchinson, Director of Secondary Education  
Re: Liability

I hereby confirm in writing what I said to you with regard to the liability of a town for injury to a pupil attending a public school, while participating in athletics or other games which are part of the physical education of students.

In the case under consideration, I understand that this pupil was struck in the face by a volley ball during the progress of a game in which she was participating, the game being a part of the school program of physical education.

The town would incur no legal liability for such an injury. . .
