To Earle R. Hayes, Secretary, Employees' Retirement System

Re: Re-employment - Retired Employee

I have talked with the Attorney General with reference to your memorandum of April 10th, and we feel that the ruling heretofore made on December 14, 1942, to which you refer, may still be adhered to, where the employment is strictly on a temporary basis, to meet a situation where the services of such employee are urgent and cannot be filled, at least for a reasonable time, with one of permanent status.
