Re: State Board for Approval of Institutions Offering Specialized Training

This is in reply to your memo of May 2nd, and I confirm the advice orally given to Mr. Weed regarding payment for services at the rate of \$10. per day plus the expenses of persons hired as consultants by the State Board. In your memo you say that the Board has appointed an advisory committee whose members are being reimbursed for their services. I am informed, however, by the Commissioner of Education that this is not so; but the Board has consulted experts in certain fields and has approved payment for their services, travel, etc.
