Re: Payment for Blood Tests

I herewith enclose letter from the County Attorney of Waldo County, two letters from the Bureau of Health, two bills addressed to Hillard H. Buzzell for \$5. each from the Bureau of Health for two blood tests, and also a copy of my letter to Mr. Buzzell.

These blood tests were ordered by the State Police, and the department ordering same is responsible for the payment, unless you can persuade the Bureau of Health to mark off these bills. According to County Attorney Buzzell's letter, this was an automobile accident in Monroe and, as there appeared to be no violation of a criminal statute, his office did not investigate.
