Your letter of July 2nd has been received, asking whether or not a rubber stamp can be construed as a seal within the meaning of the law.

I wish to state that a stamp would be sufficient under Section 15, Chapter 74, R. S. 1944, which provides:

"Reports issued by a registrant shall be stamped with the said seal, but it shall be unlawful for anyone to stamp or seal any document, etc."
