Public Park Facilities

This memo confirms what the Attorney General and I told you orally, that under the Resolve passed by the legislature, Chapter 81 of the Resolves of 1945, appropriating the sum of "\$50,000 from unappropriated surplus for the maintenance and development of public park facilities; to be expended by and under the supervision of the Maine state park commission;" the Commission is authorized in the exercise of their discretion to expend such sum for the purposes provided in said Act without the necessity of first obtaining the approval of such expenditure by any other department of the State.
