I submit the following answers to the inquiries made by
General Philoon:

1) The Treasurer or his successor holds office until his
successor is elected at the joint convention of the legislature,
and the elected official qualifies;

2) Relative to Ray S. Baker, who is now a disclosure commis-
sioner and whose term of office expires in the very near future:-
Upon his taking a seat in the Senate, he will not be eligible to
reappointment to that office. In fact, the moment he is sworn in,
he vacates the office of disclosure commissioner, as the two of-
fices cannot be held at the same time.
