Re: Dr. Harry V. Gilson - Education

Dr. Harry V. Gilson, resigned Commissioner of Education, is in the unclassified service and does not come under the jurisdiction of the Personnel Board, and upon recommendation of the head of department, Dr. Gilson may be continued on the payroll for a period of ten days, so that he may receive for said services a sum which will be in lieu of unused vacation to which he claims he was entitled upon his separation from service.

In regard to classified employees, under Rule XII, Part 2, of the Personnel Law and Rules, employees upon recommendation of the appointing authority and approval of the Director of Personnel, may receive cash for any earned vacation time not previously taken, provided his employment record is clear; but in no case shall he be paid in total more than three weeks' pay under any provisions of said rule.
